Our founding members all shared a common bond with well over one million other Wisconsinites. Being active in the outdoors is very important to mental and physical well-being of us all.

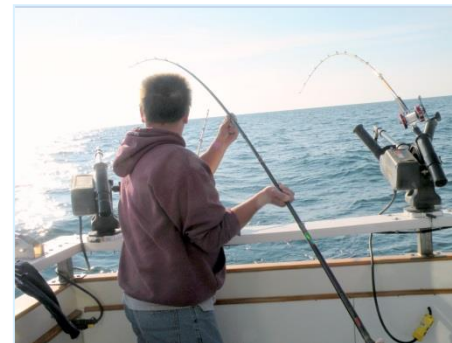
Knowing this, and with a bit of help, we could assist other physically challenged persons to share in the same delight of fishing and hunting again. With this in mind, our mission statement was born.

## All Volunteer Organization

Our organization is put together of 100% volunteers. Building deer blinds for the disabled hunt, cooking, assisting individuals with fishing and hunting events, driving gators for needed transportation, and many other helpful tasks. Volunteers are the backbone that enables us to accomplish our mission.

## A Successful Fund Raiser...

...plays an important part in enabling us to finance our events, and to provide for the physically challenged persons to safely participate in outdoor activities.

In April, we hold a **Sporting Clays Fund-raiser** hosted by J&H Game Farm (located near Navarino.) The shoot consists of 50 clay targets set up at different stations.
